TITLE: NON-ASBESTOS FRICTION MATERIAL EVALUATION

OBJECTIVE AND SCOPE: This project will be an on-going program to monitor and evaluate non-asbestos type friction lining materials as they become available. Samples will be tested on our Friction Material Test Machine on the basis of coefficient of friction, wear rate, fade, aggressiveness, etc.

BUSINESS RATIONALE: As a dry type of friction material, asbestos is the best material in existence today. Unfortunately, asbestos has been found to be a health hazard unless stringently controlled. Major friction lining suppliers are working on alternate materials. Just recently, Raybestos Manhattan, a major supplier of friction material, has made a commitment to eliminate asbestos from all of its friction linings by January 1, 1982. It is expected that other companies will eventually follow suit.
