Respondent, Union Carbide Corporation, by its attorney, answers the Complaint issued by the Department of Labor and dated April 24, 1980 as follows:

1. Respondent denies each and every allegation contained in the Introductory Paragraph of the Complaint, Paragraphs IV, V and VI in their entirety.

2. Respondent admits all the allegations contained in Paragraphs I and II of the Complaint, except the statement of Respondent's name in Paragraph II.

3. Respondent denies each and every allegation in Paragraph III of the Complaint except that Respondent admits that, on or about March 13, 1980, an inspection was conducted at Respondent's Texas City, Texas workplace and that Citation No. S6329-019 was issued.

4. Respondent denies any and all allegations of Paragraph IV of the Complaint and denies that Complainant has lawfully amended the Citation herein.

5. Respondent admits Paragraph VII of the Complaint.

AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSE

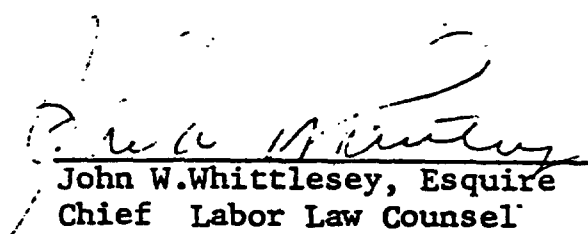
6. The Complaint, on its face, fails to state a claim upon which relief may be granted.

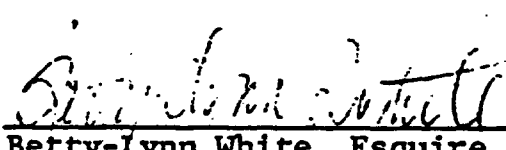
