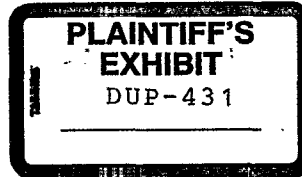

ASBESTOS

Following are the answers to the questions in your letter of November 8, 1966:

- A. We have no full time insulators at the Baltimore Plant.
- B. We have ten employees doing part time insulating work 20% of the time.
- C. Three most prevalent types of insulating materials are:
 - 1. 85% Magnesia
 - 2. Fiberglass Bats
 - 3. Insulating Cement composed of mineral wool pellets, asbestos fibers and bonding clays.
- D. We do not spray insulating materials.
- E. We have had no employees with Asbestosis, Mesothelioma, or Carcinomas among insulators.
- F. No special safety precautions have been taken for insulation.
