Please just let us know how you think we should proceed and we will do our best to accommodate you. My contact info is as follows:

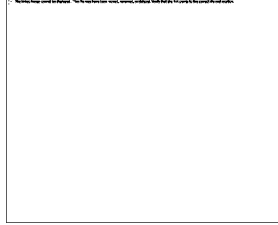
