- 1) Select "County"
- 2) Select "Region 3 – Pennsylvania"
- 3) Select the pollutants of interest (use the instructions above the dialog boxes to select all or multiple entries)
- 4) Select all sectors of interest
- 5) Click "Create CSV File". The data should come down and you can open in Excel to compare Allegheny county to the other counties in PA.

If more counties are needed than just PA, select additional states in step 2.
