Gentlemen:

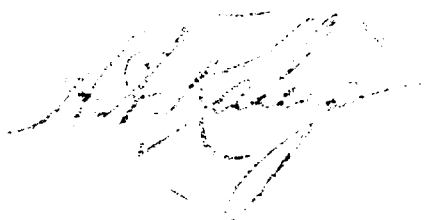
You will all be interested in the recent ruling of the Texas Company which has just been called to our attention by Mr. Murphy.

The Texas Company have decided to eliminate the periodic cleaning of tanks among their Manufacturing, Marketing, and Technical Departments. This subject came up for discussion a short time ago and a committee was appointed to study the necessity of periodic tank cleanings. Their findings indicated that there was no necessity for this and, therefore, in the future loaded gasoline storage tanks will be cleaned only for the following reasons:

1. Contamination of product
2. Repairs
3. Change of product necessitating a clean tank

This should cut down the large number of tank entrances for the Texas Company which have been called to our attention in the past.
