Dear Dr. Kehoe,

When Mr. Alan Clark, General Manager of the Clark Brothers Chewing Gum Company, talked with me last Friday, he said he would consult with you immediately to ask you to test the chicle, which they have in their warehouses, for X contents. He agreed to temporarily withhold from use any chicle which might contain more than the allowable limit of X until they had the opportunity to install the centrifuge.

We would be only too glad to have you act as consultant to the Clark Brothers Chewing Gum Company in connection with this matter of contamination. In the meantime, will you undertake, for our account, to purchase sufficient of the Clark gum in the open market to make a weekly sampling for X during the balance of this year? We would like to have these reports rendered currently as soon as possible. It is the general custom in the chewing gum trade to stamp the date of manufacture on the bottom of the display box, containing the twenty packages of gum. If you can find any such date on the boxes containing the samples purchased, we would like to have this date in connection with the reports on the findings.
