SUBJECT News Release - Illegal Paint

H.S.A.'s Bureau of Lead Poisoning Control, disclosed that ten companies are selling highly leaded paints in violation of the New York City Health Code.

One hundred and thirty-eight cans of interior paint from 23 companies were tested for lead content. Twenty-four cans from 10 companies were found to be highly leaded. All companies have been notified to take immediate action to rectify the situation.

Dr. Vincent F. Guinee, Director of the Bureau of Lead Poisoning Control noted that the amount of lead in the paint was found to be as high as 17.6 percent. Most of the paints in violation contained over 6 percent lead. The New York City Health Code prohibits the sale of paint labeled for interior use if it contains more than 1 percent lead.

H.S.A.'s program of notification and publication had resulted in 19 companies removing illegal paint from retail stores in the New York City areas over the past 18 months. //

Paint surveys will continue to be done by the Bureau. "The consumer can only go by what is written on the label. It is up to us to make sure that the label is telling the truth." Guinee said.

The offending batches of paint are being placed under embargo in the retail stores where they were found and also at the manufacturing plants if located in New York City.

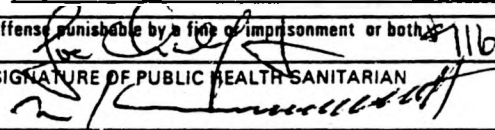

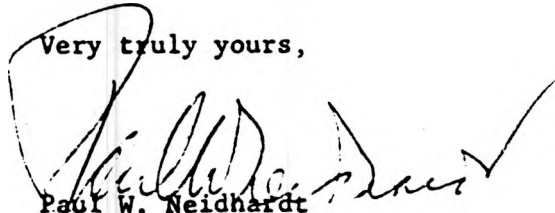
This letter will supplement and update Mr. Rechin's letter to you of August 24, 1971. It has now been brought to our attention that additional containers of certain colors of our former Japalac line have been found in retail establishments in the New York City metropolitan area. As indicated to you earlier, this particular line was discontinued in 1967 and had been reformulated to contain less than 1% lead in all colors in 1963.

You are advised that we will exercise due diligence and make our best efforts to recall all such Japalac paint containing more than 1% lead. We will notify all of our distributors and will use our own staff to try to run down and recall all such products from customers with whom we no longer have a business relationship.

It should be noted however, that while we will do our best to recall these products, that retailers having possession of such items likewise have a certain responsibility. It should be further noted that we may well have some difficulty in obtaining the recall of all of the outstanding products. This effort will take time to accomplish and very possibly may not be successful in recalling all such products which may be available for sale in the New York City area.

We trust the above indicates our sincere desire to be cooperative in efforts to remove such paint from the normal channels of public distribution.

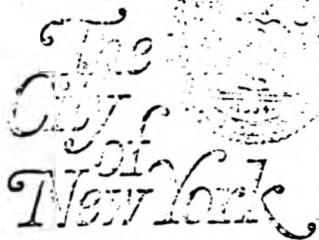
