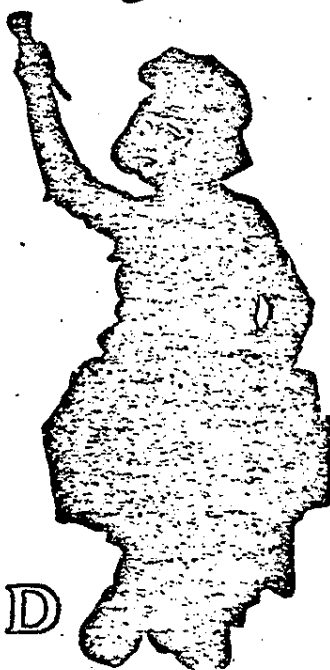

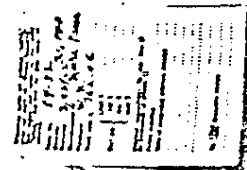
What Makes Cut Glass So Heavy
