Dear Louis,

Thank you for your letter of October 22nd with the attachment from Jack Cole on the possibility of organic lead being found in the separators at refineries. Since Continental at Baltimore will shortly be cleaning their separator, I suggest you have Mr. Cole take one or more samples and properly identify them and send them to Cincinnati for analysis. As you point out, there may be a large volume of inorganic lead from treating processes which has no relation to fluid which severs.
