Enclosed you will find the form of the Assessable Tonnage for our company.

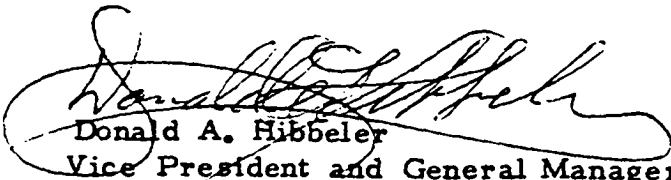
Your letter of April 22nd, indicates that we will be assessed only for one half year.
