SUBJECT SPRED URETHANE SATIN SHEEN Y-37-L Mr. W. M. Tomc

We are removing the lead drier in the Y-37-L to conform to the Chicago lead law. Speed of dry is being maintained by increasing the manganese drier. By replacing Active-8 with zirconium dry was again maintained with a cost savings of 1¢ per gallon. There has been no change in gloss, viscosity, adhesion and anti-skinning properties.
