Subject: Steelers team boycotts anthem

Every player on the Pittsburgh Steelers except one stayed in the locker room during the National Anthem for Sunday afternoon's game against the Chicago Bears, an apparent pushback against President Donald Trump's statements over the weekend attacking the NFL. That player stood near the entrance to the field.

The action by the Steelers came as an increasing number of players throughout the league - including members of the two NFL teams playing in London - were kneeling or otherwise making gestures in the spirit of former 49ers quarterback Colin Kaepernick, who remains without an NFL contract.
