Item 13145 - INVENTORY - APRIL 30th

Messrs. Mills, Rinkoski and Lemperly to see that a larger gallonege of warehouse stocks are moved out to dealers and stores where they can be sold.

Item 13148 - RAW MATERIALS

Vehicle from Ford Motor Company - Mr. Hennig to have Goldberg work closely with Cook and Ford representatives in Washington in order to obtain this.

Turpentine - Tentative approval given a \$3200 installation in Michigan subject to our obtaining a suitable contract assuring us the refusal on future out-put.

Rosin - Purchasing Department authorized to cover for six months on light grades.

Tall Oil - Mr. Hornaday to check the possibility of shipping tank cars to Cuba. (Mr. Coolidge informed that tank cars are available.)

Item 13150 - CAN PRODUCTION

Reject plate to be purchased with understanding that it can be used free of quota for fibre cans.

Item 13152 - NAPHTHYL-ACETIC ACID

Mr. Steudel asks Sales Department to make special effort to secure more business from such users as Cal Spray and Niagara Spray.

Item 13157 - 2's, 5's AND DRUMS

Mr. Hennig to determine our quota on basis of 95% by weight of 1943 usage.
Mr. Mills to report our inventory of used and good second-hand drums.

Mr. Steudel asks special effort through dealers and stores for painter business. Sales Department to follow.
