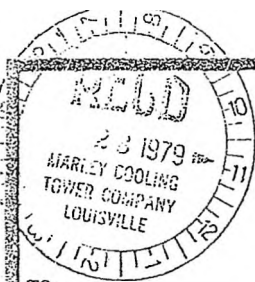

TYPE OF ALLEGED VIOLATION(S) SERIOUS

An inspection was made on February 27, 28, March 2, 3, 8, April 16, 19 79 of a place of employment located at: 4729 Allmond Avenue, Louisville, Kentucky and described as follows: make asbestos and PVC liners for cooling towers

On the basis of the inspection it is alleged that you have violated the provisions of KRS Chapter 338 (Relating to Kentucky Occupational Safety and Health) in the following respects:

ASKED FOR EXTENSION ON 4/26/79 - OK OUTLINE</i>	Asbestos waste, scrap and debris, consigned for disposal, which may produce airborne levels of asbestos fibers in excess of prescribed limits were not collected and disposed of in sealed impermeable bags or other closed impermeable containers. 	1910.1001(j)(1) <i>HAVE OUR INS. PEOPLE IN AGAIN.</i>	Medical examinations were not provided for employees who were exposed to asbestos fibers greater than .1 fibers/ml ³ , at the cost of the employer as required by this paragraph.	June 22, 1979

The citation must remain posted until all alleged violations cited therein are corrected, or for 3 working days*, whichever period is longer.

RIGHTS OF EMPLOYEES

Any employee or representative of employees who believes that any period of time fixed in this citation for the correction of a violation is unreasonable has the right to contest such time for correction by filing a notice with the Kentucky Department of Labor at the address shown above within 15 working days* of the issuance of this citation.

"No person shall discharge or in any manner discriminate against any employee because such employee has filed any complaint or instituted or caused to be instituted any proceeding under or related to this Chapter or has testified or is about to testify in such proceeding or because of the exercise by such employee on behalf of himself or others of any right afforded by this Chapter." KRS 338.121(3)(a).

*803 KAR 2:040 the term "Working Day" means Mondays through Fridays but does not include Saturdays, Sundays, Federal or State holidays.

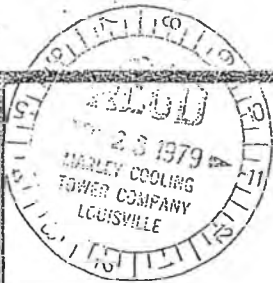
