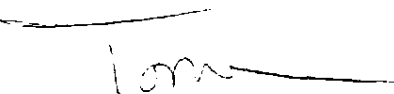
SUBJ: FOOD CODEX NOTIFICATION FOR MURIATIC ACID CUSTOMERS

Based on conversations with the Baltimore plant regarding the current operating conditions and analytical procedures for muriatic acid, we need to change the statement for customers to read as follows:

"It is our understanding that the Food Codex has published a new monograph for organic contaminants in by-product muriatic acid. Vista muriatic acid normally meets the limits specified in the monograph.

This change accurately reflects current conditions. To absolutely assure that every load leaving the plant meets the specifications we need to review current plant analysis frequency and filter change frequency and make changes where necessary.
