Mixture of East and West

Toynbee Sees World Society for Future

LONDON (AP) — Arnold J. Toynbee, the distinguished historian, philosopher, and statesman, today said he was convinced that the future will bring East and West together in a new world society.

He said that the mixture of the two civilizations will start mainly on a Western basis. The eminent English scholar brings an Olympian approach to the study of mankind. He sees his very falling into civilization patterns and views them in the whole context of their life spans.

Forsees Defiance In an interview with The Associated Press as he approached his birthday next Tuesday, he foresees a defiance between the Soviet Union and the United States.

The interview was in his study at the Royal Institute of International Affairs where he has been director for 30 years. Soon after, he left for Africa to begin a new project at the University of Libya on his birthday. He wife became 70 while they were in Ethiopia. He also visited Nigeria, Sudan and the United Arab Republic.

"America is becoming a bit of a free enterprise country. I think there will be a compromise between Western civilization and the others."

Common World "There will be mixture, a common world civilization that will start by being on a Western basis. It will be altered as different people come into it."

He thinks that what is most likely to happen is that the West will provide the framework for the new world society which will be mainly Western to start, but as the Chinese become more important — and the Africans to some degree — they'll put their civilizations into this."

Toynbee's monumental "A Study of History" made a great impression on the scholarly world. He began the 12-volume study in 1927 and finished it in 1961 — all written in his home.

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S.F. Birth Control Issue

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — A controversy swirled today over deletion by Mayor John F. Shelley of a \$10,840 item from the city budget for birth control services at San Francisco General Hospital.

"No one said how the money was to be used or what for or how it was to be administered," explained Shelley.

Shelley had asked Dr. Ellis D. Sox, the city health director, and Sherman F. Duckel, the chief administrative officer, but got no answers.

Sox denied he was asked. Duckel said the mayor simply told him the item "was out."

Dr. John Schaupp, president of the San Francisco County Medical Society, did the unusual thing of calling a society — authorized news conference at which he accused the mayor of "denying adequate medical care of underprivileged San Francisco citizens."

Schaupp, in reply to a question, quoted Shelley, who is a Catholic, as saying his decision "was not a religious one."

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
