* I know that you will be as surprised as we were to learn that by decision filed August 16, 1950, copy of which is enclosed, the New York Workmen's Compensation Board reversed the decision of the Referee in the subject case and found that claimant is suffering from lead poisoning due to exposure to ethyl lead, tetraethyl and gasoline fumes while in the course of his employment with Shell, and therefore sustained an occupational disease within the meaning of the statute. We should be pleased to hear from you after you have had an opportunity to read the Board's decision.
