NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED AIR QUALITY CRITERIA

1. Section 5 (f) (8) of the Pennsylvania Air Pollution Control Act, the Act of January 8, 1960, P.L. 2119 as amended, provides that "the Commission shall have the power and its duty shall be to establish and publish maximum quantities of air contaminants that may be permitted under various conditions at the point of use from any air contaminant source in various areas of the Commonwealth so as to control air pollution."
2. On July 28, 1964 the Commission appointed a Council of Technical Advisors on Ambient Air Quality Criteria. On November 14, 1966 the Council submitted the attached proposed criteria to the Commission and the Commission accepted the criteria "for purposes of public hearing."
3.
