Also, since the April 28 announcement, what actual updates have been incorporated into the site? Any beyond those mentioned online at the site as of today? If not -- is there a schedule for making progress on the updates? What level of staff resources is being devoted to making the updates? Are they on a deadline?

I want to post this piece ASAP, given that we're now at the four-month point since the initial announcement of the pending changes. If you are unable for whatever reason to get back to me....please at least tell me that so I can move forward. (I've also put in a written request to the site through the official online process -- again, no response.)
