

1 A thick envelope around the pleura,
2 shortness of breath with minimal exertion in February,
3 thin and chronically ill. Left lung almost completely
4 opacified.

5 It is getting to be around this time, May.
6 You heard Dr. Rubin, you heard Dr. Hammar explain what
7 that effect has on chest wall mechanics and what it
8 does.

9 Then in February of 1993, do you remember he
10 was treated with some chemotherapy, that slow attempt,

14 where almost that top layer of your mouth and the
