SUBJECT: Vinyl Training Review

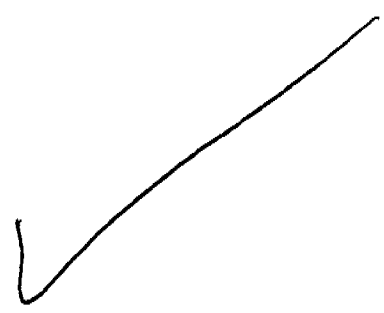
