Dear Doctor Kahoe:

On March 12, 1929, you furnished us a very comprehensive and sympathetic statement of your study of the case of Mr. [REDACTED] who since about June, 1924, has been suffering physical and psychic consequence of tetraethyl lead poisoning at that time.

For the past two years Mr. [REDACTED] has been receiving disability benefits under a policy of insurance in this Association held by him. We now have under consideration the question of the justification of the further and future continuance of these disability benefits. It is very difficult to appraise the merits of the case, and to form a just decision as to what the applicant is entitled to under the circumstances.
