This is to advise that Mr. [Redacted] died on [Redacted] while a patient at Kaiser Foundation Hospital in Oakland, California. The cause of death was congestive heart failure with associated lung disease. The deceased left a widow and two children. Should an industrial death claim be made, the exposure would be \$28,000 plus \$1,000 towards burial expense.

As you know, we had [Redacted] examined by a specialist on February 10, 1973, and we are awaiting this doctor's report, following his review of the extensive hospital records. Until we see that report, and determine what part, if any, the employment played in causing or aggravating the man's condition, it is difficult to assess our liability. As soon as this can be done, we shall let you know.
