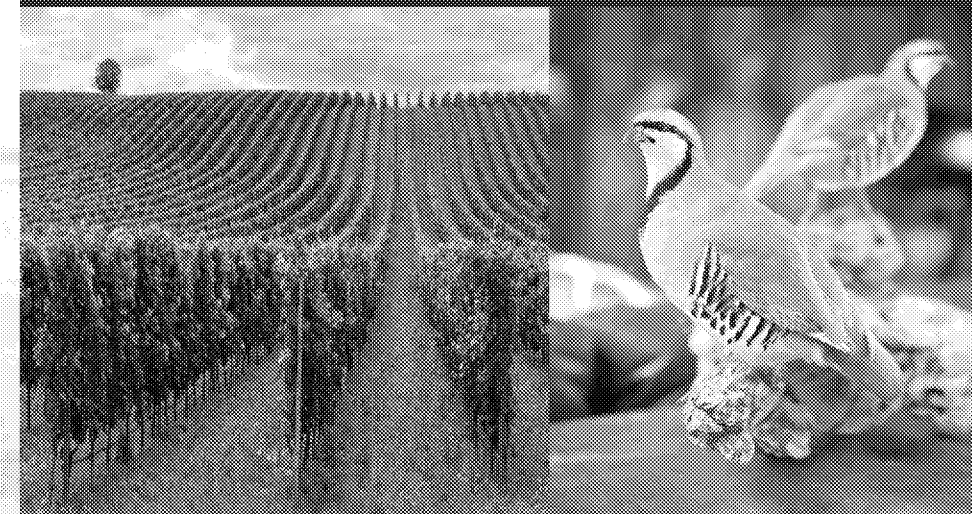

CSF is committed to continuing to advance sportsmen's priorities in the Golden State, and is investing more resources to do just that. In 2016, CSF placed full-time policy staff in Sacramento to support the California Outdoor Sporting Caucus and coordinate efforts with the sportsmen's community. In recent years, CSF staff have worked with legislators, state and federal agencies, and sportsmen and women in California to:

- Educate decision-makers about the economic, conservation, and cultural benefits of hunting, angling, and recreational shooting.
- Appoint pro-sportsmen members to the California Fish and Game Commission.
- Procure official acknowledgement of National Hunting and Fishing Day from Governor Brown.
- Defeat multiple proposals to limit access to recreational fishing and traditional fishing tackle.

### Economic Impact of Hunting and Angling in California

California is home to 1.82 million hunters and anglers who spend upwards of \$3.5 billion, generating \$488 million in state and local taxes. Through the American System of Conservation Funding, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife received \$131.7 million from California's hunters and anglers in 2015 alone.
