

from Washington downtown and Reagan National Airport, anticipate two hours and ten minutes. Private vehicle is the only practical means to reach the location. Within Skyland, all facilities are walkable. Travel on Skyline Drive will be heavy on the weekend, and the road is highly scenic but narrow and with lots of curves and distracted drivers.

Attire: We are meeting in a national park. Attire that allows outside enjoyment is appropriate. Khakis/jeans and logoed collared shirts would be fine – because of elevation, layered attire is appropriate – and bring raingear/umbrella, sunglasses (and cameras and binocs). Shoes for significant walking are needed. No suits.
