3 With this information in hand, you can then
4 decide whether you care to go into an experiment of a
5 larger scale for which our charge is \$5,000 for the
6 first year and less in the succeeding ones as the
7 number of animals to be kept under observations
8 decreases.

10 Honor, is document Number 20 offered against Owens-
11 Illinois and Owens-Corning.

12 It is a document from Dr. Leroy U. Gardner,
13 Director of Saranac Lab to Mr. U. E. Bowes, Director
14 of Research, Owens-Illinois Glass Company dated May
15 31, 1944.
