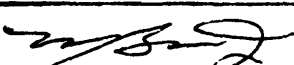

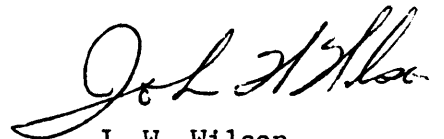
Please find attached an 830 Work Order for \$12600 to cover the cost of removing damaged asbestos insulation from steam piping.

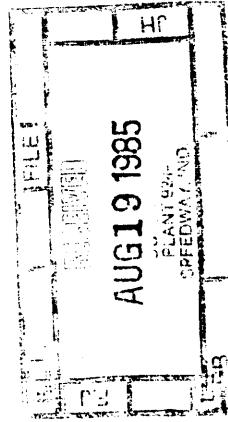

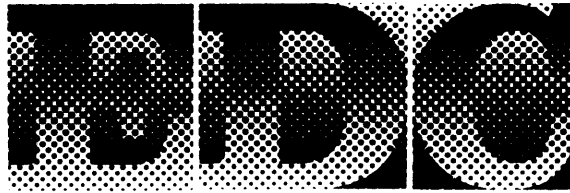

Gentlemen:

Per your request, I wish to confirm to you our recommended procedure on the subject project. All interiors, asbestos piping has had all repairs and punctures sealed with 80Z canvas and fiberglass insulation installed where there were voids or missing insulation. Existing insulation and all repairs have been sealed with A.B.C. asbestos binding compound. We guarantee that this project has been installed properly, but we would recommend that if coating is damaged in the future, that it be repaired as soon as possible. It is our opinion that this piping was, in most cases, in excellent condition with at least two coats of paint prior to this application. Yard piping which contained asbestos with a felt weatherproof jacket was sealed then covered with 1" Fiberglass with a sealed vapor barrier jacket and then covered and sealed with an 016 aluminum jacket with vapor barrier.

I have enclosed manufacturing data sheet on encapsulation.

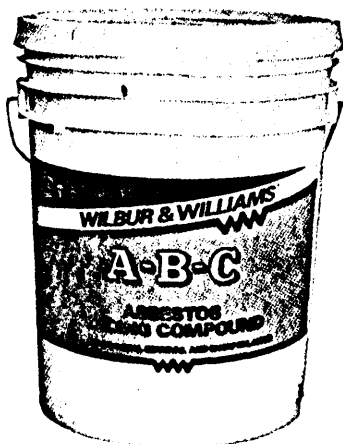

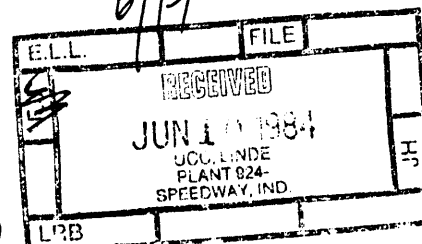

Gaskets Containing Asbestos - Fabrication and Removal

SCOPE This procedure is designed to give minimum safety/health/ environmental requirements when fabricating, handling, or removing gaskets containing asbestos.

HAZARDS Exposure to asbestos fibers can increase the risk of developing certain diseases. Refer to MP-I-6.

PHILOSOPHY Employees working with asbestos materials are required to practice good personal hygiene and safe work practices. They are also required to limit exposure to asbestos by wearing the proper respiratory protection and following the proper guidelines and work practices.

PERMISSIBLE EXPOSURE LIMITS

Asbestos dust concentrations must not exceed an 8-hour Time Weighted Average (TWA): .2 fibers longer than 5 micrometers, per cubic centimeter of air. At no time may the "ceiling" concentration exceed 10 fibers (longer than 5 micrometers) per cubic centimeter of air.

WORK PRACTICES

These work practices apply to the use of non-friable asbestos-containing compressed material when furnished as precut gaskets or in sheets and rolls.

Operations to which these work practices apply include:

- A. Storage
- B. Identification
- C. Fabrication
- D. Installation
- E. Replacement
- F. Housekeeping
- G. Waste Disposal

A. Storage

Gasket materials are typically received in three forms: sheets, rolls, and precut gaskets. Storage areas should be kept clean and dust free, either by wet sweeping or with the use of a vacuum cleaner fitted with a high efficiency particulate aerosol (HEPA) filter. Contact the plant B & R Insulator Foreman for a properly equipped vacuum cleaner.

B. Identification

New gaskets and bulk gasket material containing asbestos should be identified using the yellow and black stick-on labels, stores item (63486160).

C. Fabrication

1. Handpunching

Bolt holes are often made with the use of a hand punch and mallet. If feasible, the material should be dampened while it is being worked. Areas where hand punching takes place should be kept clean and dust free. Scraps of waste should be disposed of in the proper manner (see waste disposal section).

2. Hand Shaping

Hand shaping of gaskets is carried out with the use of a scribe, pocket knife, or scissors. Gasket sizes are scribed onto a flat sheet of asbestos gasket material and then cut by the use of scissors or a pocket knife. The gasket material should be dampened during scribing and cutting, if feasible. In this operation, as in others involving asbestos, work areas should be kept clean and dust free and waste scraps should be promptly disposed of in the proper manner (see waste disposal section).

NOTE:

1. Large pieces of gasket material left after the fabrication operation may be returned to storage for future use.

D. Gasket Replacement - Removal and Installation

Replacing gaskets often requires the use of a scraper or wire brush to remove all of the old gasket material from the flange surface, before a new gasket is put into place. Begin by prying or levering off the old gasket with a knife or scraper in order to remove it in the largest possible pieces. When practicable, surfaces to be scraped, ground, or brushed should be wetted. If wetting is allowed, respiratory protection and/or glove bags will not be required. If wetting is not allowed, the glove bag method and/or respiratory protection may be required. The protection required should be evaluated on a job-by-job basis. If unusual conditions exist or there are questions about whether glove bags or respirators should be required, the Industrial Hygiene Department must be contacted prior to beginning work.

Gaskets Containing Asbestos - Fabrication and Removal

1. Some gaskets may be coated or surface treated with a parting agent so that when gaskets are removed, there is no need for excess grinding, scraping or brushing.
2. Other special gaskets, such as asbestos filled Flexitallic, double jacketed asbestos filled, etc. require no special handling under normal conditions. If these type gaskets are damaged exposing asbestos, the above requirements apply.

E. Housekeeping and Waste Disposal

Airborne asbestos dust created by the lack of good housekeeping has the potential for harm to employees and others. Keep work areas clean by wet wiping or wet sweeping, or by vacuuming with a unit equipped with a high efficiency particulate aerosol (HEPA) filter. NEVER DRY SWEEP OR BLOW ASBESTOS WITH COMPRESSED AIR.

F. Waste Disposal

Scraps from gasket cutting, old gaskets, materials used to clean up dust and waste, etc. are considered plant hazardous waste and must be bagged in approved disposal bags, stores item (14-103-602) and disposed of in the plant non-hazardous landfill. An "order for waste removal" form must be obtained from the E.P. Department.

GENERAL

This procedure is for the safe removal and handling of asbestos-containing material in compliance with OSHA 29 CFR 1910.1001, Construction Industry Standard 1926 and UCC SH 256. The purpose is to ensure the safety and health of persons directly involved with performing the work and others, who may be exposed to airborne dust/fibers. Insulation and other materials shall be considered to contain asbestos if the content is greater than 0.1%.

STANDARDS

Permissible Exposure Limits:

The permissible exposure limit is 0.2 fiber per cubic centimeter of air (f/CC), as an 8-hour time-weighted average, airborne, with an action level of 0.1 f/CC.

WORK PRACTICES

- A. Only specially trained and qualified persons meeting medical requirements of OSHA General Industry Standard 1910.1001, J, shall be employed in removal or demolition of asbestos where the possible exposure could exceed permissible limits.
- B. When asbestos is suspected, the Industrial Hygiene Department will be contacted to make a positive determination. If the material is asbestos, it will be marked by qualified inspectors using yellow and black stick-on labels, (Stores Item 63-486-160).
- C. Demolition, removal or handling of asbestos-containing materials shall be performed in a manner that will prevent emission of airborne fibers.
- D. Danger signs and barricades shall be posted at all approaches to areas which may contain airborne asbestos fibers, in concentrations which may exceed the permissible exposure limit, (regulated area), so that an employee may take necessary protective steps before entering the area. The signs are 20" x 14" with a vertical format stating:

DANGER - ASBESTOS; CANCER AND LUNG DISEASE HAZARD; AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY;
RESPIRATORS AND PROTECTIVE CLOTHING ARE REQUIRED IN THIS AREA.

These signs are Stores Item #63486-120.

- E. In case of repair or transport of an object that is asbestos insulated, remove insulation as required, then coat or encapsulate any exposed surfaces with surfactant, mastic or poly film. Mark the object using labels as described in "B".
- F. The Transportation Group will be notified when asbestos is to be transported. The person requesting transport is responsible for notification and will make sure that the item is prepared as in E.

- G. Salvage or demolition of asbestos covered equipment will be done on site using practices as required by this procedure, and Construction Industry Standard 1926.58.
- H. Bags & Labels: Special reinforced plastic bags are used by plant personnel for bagging and disposing of asbestos insulation, Stores Item #14-103-602. Special labels for the bags are in Stores, Item #64-486-160. The label states:

DANGER
CONTAINS ASBESTOS FIBERS
AVOID CREATING DUST
CANCER AND LUNG DISEASE HAZARD

- I. Removal: Will be done in accordance with Guidelines per 29 CRF 1926.58, Appendix F. A regulated area must be established. This area may take the form of (1) a temporary enclosure as required by paragraph (e) (6) or (2) an area demarcated in a manner that minimizes the number of persons within the area and protects persons outside the area from exposure to airborne concentrations of asbestos.
- J. Exception: For small scale, short duration activities a Glove Bag Method of removal may be used as described in Construction Industry Standard 1926.58, Appendix G.
- K. Waste Disposal - Asbestos waste, scrap, debris, bags, containers, equipment, and contaminated disposable clothing, which may produce airborne concentrations of asbestos fibers in excess of prescribed exposure limits shall be collected and disposed of in sealed impermeable bags, or other closed impermeable containers in an approved landfill. A waste removal order must be obtained from the EP Department.
- L. Asbestos Removal Temporary Enclosure - See page 5.

HOUSEKEEPING

All external surfaces shall be maintained free of accumulations of asbestos fibers, if, with their dispersion, there would be an excessive concentration. Special attention should be given to cleaning scaffolds used in demolition work.

PERSONNEL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

All persons engaged in the removal of asbestos are required to wear a Seadrift Plant approved respirator and approved protective clothing.

- A. Approved respirators are: The North Half Mask with 7500B cartridge (purple color) U.S. Safety Half Mask with 158-7-12 cartridge (purple color), M.S.A. Face Mask Respirator with type "H" (purple color) cartridge, the Full Face Mask supplied Air Respirator self contained breathing unit (Scott Air Pack), or the powered air purifying respirator (upon request).

- B. Coveralls: White paper (63-129-010) or yellow vinyl (63-380-120) and cotton coveralls, bright orange color, marked "asbestos removal" on back. These coveralls are washed and stored in the dirty or (contaminated) area of the Decon Trailer. Control, laundering and disposal to be in accordance with 29 CFR 1910.1001, (4) (H) (3).
- C. Other protective clothing includes head covers, over shoes, rubber boots, foot covers and vinyl or rubber gloves.

INDUSTRIAL HYGIENE RESPONSIBILITY

1. Employee exposure monitoring will be conducted as required by regulations.
2. Positive determination of asbestos content (Work Practices, B) Page 1.

MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS

Medical examinations for persons doing asbestos removal and/or demolition must be conducted in accordance with OSHA Regulations, 29 CFR 1910.1001, and UCC Corporation Occupation and Health Medical Manual.

TRAINING

All employees who work with airborne asbestos concentrations, at or above the action level, must participate in an annual training program that includes these information topics:

- A. Health affects associated with asbestos exposure.
- B. Relationship between exposure to asbestos and smoking in producing lung cancer.
- C. The quantity, location, manner of use, release and storage of asbestos and the specific nature of operations which could result in exposure to asbestos. Necessary protective steps to minimize exposure including, as applicable, engineering controls, work practices, respirators, housekeeping and protective clothing.
- D. The engineering controls and work practices associated with the employers job assigned.
- E. Purpose, proper use, fitting instructions, and limitations of respirators and protective clothing. Initial training and annual retraining will be documented and recorded.
- F. Review of all provisions contained in 29 CFR 1910.1001, Asbestos and the specific procedures implemented to protect employees from asbestos exposure.
- G. Instructions for handling spills as well as emergency and clean-up procedures.
- H. The purpose and description of the Medical Surveillance Program.

RECORD KEEPING

- A. Applicable asbestos training and medical records for UCC employees will be maintained by the location for 30 years.
- B. Applicable asbestos training, retraining, and medical records for contract employees will be maintained by the contractor as required by OSHA Regulations, and will be available to UCC upon request.

ASBESTOS REMOVAL NOTIFICATION/EPA Reg. 40 CFR 61

When demolition or removal involves more than 160 square feet or 260 lineal feet of insulation containing more than one percent asbestos by weight, either in a single project or in a predictable series of projects over a course of one year that are additive to this amount, it must be reported as follows:

- A. The department in which the removal takes place notifies the EP Department at least 10 days prior to planned demolition or as soon as possible after beginning an unplanned (Emergency) project which exceeds the limits.
- B. The EP Department notifies the appropriate Federal and State agencies.

OTHER:

For further information on asbestos removal and disposal refer to OSHA Regulation 29 CFR 1910.1001, Construction Industry Standard 1926, Federal EP Regulation, 40 CFR 61, UCC Standard Practice, SH 256 and Occupational and Health Medical Manual, Appendix 3.

ASBESTOS REMOVAL TEMPORARY ENCLOSURE

Prior to erecting an asbestos removal enclosure, the erecting supervisor and the responsible operating department representative will inspect the area to be enclosed for potential hazards such as pipe leaks, packing leaks, safety valves or tank vents, deteriorated electrical conduit, leaking instrument tubing or any other hazardous or potentially hazardous condition. Identified hazards will be corrected before proceeding with the enclosure construction. All lines and equipment to be de-insulated within the enclosure will be identified. The unit representative will be made aware that de-insulation of equipment in poor condition can create leaks. Now Complete Section I Of Enclosure Checklist (See Page 6 For Checklist).

Erect the enclosure frame work as agreed in Step 1 of the Enclosure Checklist. Set up the negative air machine. Begin erecting the plastic walls. When the walls restrict air flow through the enclosure, start up the negative air machine and begin using the oxygen and combustible gas monitors. When the enclosure is complete, but before asbestos removal begins, conduct an interior inspection of the enclosure. The inspection team should include the unit operating representative, the asbestos removal supervisor and at least one (1) crew member. UPON COMPLETION OF SECTION II OF THE CHECKLIST ASBESTOS REMOVAL MAY BEGIN.

If a leak or other hazardous condition occurs during asbestos removal, evacuate the enclosure and notify the unit representative immediately.

Upon completion of the asbestos removal activity the enclosure will be cleaned of any remaining asbestos residue. When airborne asbestos concentration checks meet minimum requirements, the structure will be dismantled and disposed of.

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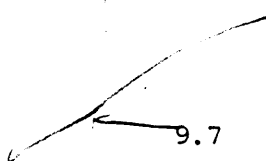

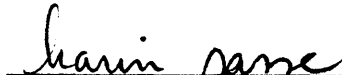

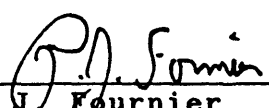
