Dear Dr. Winslow:

On my return from the Washington Congress I have seen a copy of your letter to Mr. Hellmuth of September 26. We were all dreadfully sorry you could not attend the Convention. In spite of the depression there were approximately 2000 people in attendance at the many meetings and as a whole we think it worth while to have made another demonstration of the vitality of the problems before us.

The Nominating Committee followed your instructions and placed Dr. Watson in the vice presidency for Industrial Health. Mr. Banash was elected president, Mr. George Warfel, vice president for industrial safety and Mr. R. I. Catlin of the Aetna Life Insurance Company, vice president for public safety. Only one change was made in the Executive Committee-at-large, namely, putting Mr. C. W. Smith of the Standard Oil Company of Indiana, in Mr. Bergquist's place who now retires to the list of Past Presidents. You have been continued, of course, as a member of the Executive Committee-at-large.

Had you been present at our Sunday morning meeting you would have been interested in the Finance Committee's report recommending some further reductions in our expenses. It has been decided to close up the Industrial Health Department for the present and Dr. Sappington and his secretary have been given salary checks and in the hope that they can place their services satisfactorily elsewhere. No move will be made for the present to replace either of these two employees. I talked this over with Dr. Watson in Washington and he was fully in accord with the decision.

The next meeting of the Executive Committee will be in Chicago, Monday, November 21.
