Dear Mr. Bryant:

Your letter of July 31 came as a considerable surprise to me, and I am naturally curious to know what Mr. Flaherty plans to do if anything, toward the correction of the serious hazards associated with the operation of the New Castle plant. I have had no communication of any kind from him nor any of the other people, and I presume that they have no intention of carrying any relationship with this Laboratory further. This is quite all right with me and I would not mention it except for the fact that if they were to wish it, I could give them a summary of the results obtained that might be useful to them in appraising the present hygienic status of their plant. If you should have any means of bringing this to their attention, I shall, of course, be quite glad to summarize our results and give them the benefit of my parting advice.

As to your own situation, I am frank to say that I have no suggestion at the moment. My knowledge of these matters is confined almost entirely to the medical and hygienic situations. However, I shall keep my eyes open, and if anything comes to my attention which would seem to be of any interest to you, I should be glad to let you know.

I have been very glad to work with you on the problem that presented itself at the New Castle plant. I do not consider that I was able to accomplish much, but on the other hand, I cannot feel that this was your fault. I trust that your next opportunity with work of this kind will give you more fruitful field.
