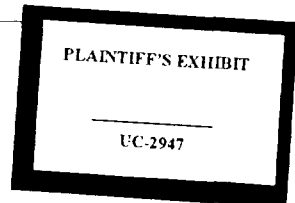

In accordance with requirements of 40 CFR 61, Subpart B, Section 61.22(d), the following information concerning removal and disposal of friable asbestos is provided. This notification represents an approximation of renovation work planned for 1980.

- I. NAME OF OWNER - Union Carbide Corporation
- II. ADDRESS OF OWNER - P. O. Box 180, Sistersville, W. Va. 26175
- III. DESCRIPTION OF FACILITY - Approximately 1000 linear feet to be removed
- IV. ADDRESS OF SITE - Same as above
- V. SCHEDULE START AND COMPLETION DATES - January - December 1980
- VI. NATURE OF PLANNED RENOVATION AND METHODS EMPLOYED - Deteriorated asbestos containing insulation is wetted in accordance with Section 61.22(d)(4)(ii) and removed. It is then replaced with the non-asbestos containing insulation.
- VII. DISPOSAL PRACTICES - The wetted asbestos is placed in plastic bags and buried at the plant site in accordance with Section 61.22(j) and 61.25(a), (e)(2).
- VIII. NAME AND ADDRESS OF DISPOSAL SITE - Same as above.
