Subject: Re: Query from VICE News: Additional hearings on proposed Clean Power Plan repeal

Hi Alex, attributable to an EPA spokesperson:

At this time, EPA has one hearing scheduled on the proposed repeal of the Clean Power Plan, in Charleston, West Virginia on November 28-29th, 2017. The agency looks forward to hearing from all interested stakeholders.

If the EPA receives a high volume of requests, we may continue the public hearing to November 30, 2017. EPA may also hold an additional hearing to be announced at a later date.

Written statements and supporting information submitted during the comment period will be considered with the same weight as any oral comments and supporting information presented at the public hearing. Written comments on the proposed rule may be submitted to the EPA electronically, by mail, by facsimile or through hand delivery/courier. Please refer to the proposal (82 FR 48035) for the addresses and detailed instructions. The period for providing comments to the EPA will remain open until January 16, 2018.
