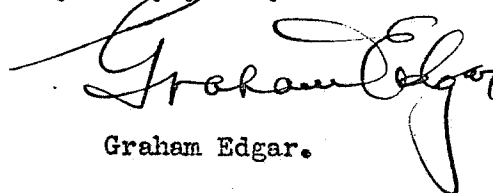
My dear Bob:
