Dear Mr. Gebhard:

Your letter of November 21st concerning your physical condition addressed to the Ethyl Gasoline Corporation has been referred to me for reply.

The description of your illness does not permit me to arrive at any opinion as to the nature of your illness or injury. It may be that you have been suffering from a skin irritation produced by gasoline, since gasoline is an irritating substance and is known to be capable of producing injury to the skin under suitable conditions. So far as I know, there is no reason to believe that Ethyl Gasoline is more irritating to the skin than are other gasolines. It is equally as likely, however, that the condition of your face may have been due to some other cause. If your doctor should care to communicate with me I might be able to make certain helpful suggestions.
