The preliminary evaluation of the environmental data collected as part of the industry-wide study of talc miners and millers has been completed.

The analysis of your Beaverhead Mine facility is included. This facility has been designated as plant number 16. This code number is unique to this facility and will appear on all summaries of data.

The respiratory dust samples were collected and analyzed according to NIOSH method SDS #29.02. This is listed in Table I.

The asbestos samples were collected and analyzed according to NIOSH method P & CAM #239. This is reported in Table II.

The crystalline silica samples were collected and analyzed according to NIOSH method P & CAM #109. This is reported in Table III.

The trace metal samples were collected and analyzed according to NIOSH method P & CAM #173. This is reported in Table IV.

The job classification codes for your facility are as follows:

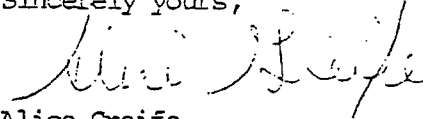
