

- 1 A Of this type of brake lining, yes.
- 2 Q Okay. Now, on Page 3 of the attachment, on disc brake
3 assembly, the second line is Dayton-Walther and it doesn't
4 have any dates after their corporate name. Would that
5 presume that all of these light truck brake assemblies
6 were supplied to Ford from the years 1970 through 1982,
7 is that what that means? I notice the year there in the
8 left column, 1970-1982.
- 9 A That is what that means to me.
- 10 Q Okay. That would also be true then for Bendix Corporation?
- 11 A Yes.
- 12 Q Now, on light trucks, what do you mean by the definition
13 light trucks? What models?
- 14 A We are talking about pickups and vans.
- 15 Q Okay.
- 16 A When we use the term light trucks, there are also raw,
17 partial chassis, if you will, which are van and pickup
18 chassis, which are described as light trucks also.
- 19 Q Are you familiar with Cribbs Ford City, a dealership in
20 St. Louis County, Missouri?
- 21 A No, I am not.
- 22 Q Do you know from what Ford plants passenger vehicles
23 have been supplied to Cribbs Ford City during the years
24 1960 through 1975?
- 25 A No, I do not. I don't know that.
