PLANT VISIT - CALVERT CHEMICAL WORKS
KENTUCKY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

A team of industrial hygienists and inspectors from the Kentucky State Department of Health visited the plant today. Their names were:

Mr. Ray Dunn - Industrial Hygienist, Dist. Office - Paducah, Kentucky

Mr. Eugene Wood - Industrial Hygienist, Frankfort, Kentucky

Mr. Buell Edwards - Inspector - Paducah, Kentucky

Their prime interest was in the PVC Operations. They were aware of the hand x-ray program and interested in what alternate methods we were considering using to clean reactors.

I informed them that we were cooperating with the MCA and the University of Michigan in a statistical study and x-ray program in an effort to find out, if possible, what seems to be the cause of this phenomenon and that we had planned no changes until we knew some answers.

Our plant was completely down, this being the one day in the year that all power is off. However, they wanted to visit the plant in this condition and also want to return when it is operating. I expect them to return next week.

R. T. Lund dropped in while they were visiting. He has been coordinating the x-ray program for the Division. He informed me that we were expecting a visit from the U. of Michigan team, September 11. He has asked J. Barr to show them through the PVC area and answer their questions.

I will keep you informed of any further developments.
