Gentlemen:

The course that [REDACTED] an was practically the same as a case of [REDACTED], with the exception that Mr. [REDACTED] had a per [REDACTED] citation which lasted three days. [REDACTED] necessitated confining him in a private room at the New Britain General Hospital with a day and night special nurse the above mentioned period. He is still hospitalized in a compensation ward and I expect to discharge him September 30th. - It will probably be two weeks before I will allow him to return to his work. I might add that his case is a little more severe than Bonini's. He is complaining of tinnitus (ringing of the ears). I do not believe this will be permanent.
