The asbestos reporting requirement under Section 8 (a) of TSCA issued July 30, 1982, Federal Register 47, No. 147, pp. 33198-33225, q.v. The purpose of this letter is to alert all potentially affected components who manufacture, mill, mine, import or process asbestos or asbestos mixtures to respond to me so that we may coordinate reporting and be on a uniform basis. It is my understanding that the users of asbestos products are not aware of the new rule and that the manufacturers of asbestos products are not aware of the new rule. Attached are (1) a useful Asbestos Information Association summary of the rule, and (2) pp. 33198-33203 of the rule. In enclosing only the initial pages of the rule the intent is minimization of paper flow-you are all welcome to read the Federal Register if you have the time and stomach for it. What is not evident in these summaries is that this is presently "one time only" reporting and is for what happened in 1981.
