HAZARDOUS PROPERTIES: Fairly large doses of sulfites can be tolerated. Dangerous disaster hazard. When heated to decomposition, it emits highly toxic fumes of sulfur dioxide; they will react with water, steam, or acids to produce a toxic and corrosive material.

TREATMENT:

Skin: Remove contaminated clothing. Brush off chemical immediately. Wash with water. (slightly soluble in water).

Eyes: Flush with copious amounts of water.

Swallowing: Report to First Aid.

Inhalation: Remove patient from contaminated area. Report to First Aid.
