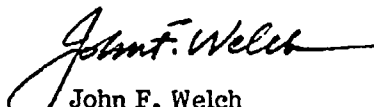
Dear Mr. Ridneour:

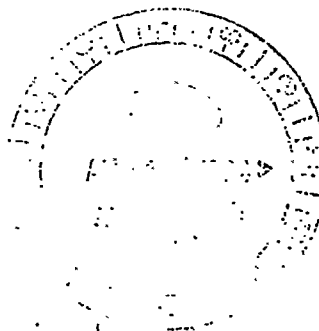
