

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO ADVERTISE FOR SEALED PROPOSALS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A CITY OF MONTEREY OF CERTAIN FIRE HOSE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONTEREY, that the City Clerk of said City be, and he is hereby, directed to publish twice in the Monterey Peninsula Herald, a newspaper of general circulation, a notice to bid and circulated six days each week in said City, and the official newspaper thereof, a copy of this Resolution inviting sealed proposals or bids for the sale to said City of the following described fire hose pursuant to the conditions hereinafter set forth:

Six hundred feet (600') of two and one-half inch (2 1/2") hose with National Standard, E. J. Fire Hose Company (cast bronze) and eight hundred feet (800') of one and one-half inch (1 1/2") hose with Pacific Coast Fire Plug type couplings cast bronze, uniform thickness and to contain not less than thirty-five per cent (35%) crude rubber.

Each of the written conditions and specifications governing the submission of proposals and bids and describing the hose to be sold to said City may be obtained from the City Clerk upon request of either the telephone or in person. No charge is made for supplying same. Each bidder shall furnish a two foot (2') sample of each size hose on which condition of the hose samples furnished shall not be returned.

Said hose proposed to be sold to said City hereunder shall be delivered to the City of Monterey within thirty (30) days after the award of contract. Terms Cash within 30 days after delivery.

Each of said bids to be considered by said Council must be accompanied by a certified check payable to the City of Monterey in the sum of not less than ten per cent (10%) of the total aggregate of the bids.

An interpretation of the specifications or questions as to details will be given by the City Manager in writing upon request.

Each of said bids to be considered by said Council shall be delivered to the City Clerk of said City or filed in his office not later than the first of each of the following dates: on or before 10 o'clock p.m. on the 21st day of May 1951, at which date and hour in the Council Chamber of the City Hall to-wit: Few Memorial Hall of Records said Council will publicly open and examine the bids to reject any and all such bids.
