

PFOA and PFOS Health Advisories
SUMMARY OF UNREGULATED CONTAMINANT MONITORING INFORMATION

EPA's third Unregulated Contaminant Monitoring Rule (UCMR 3) required approximately 5,000 public water systems to monitor for PFOA and PFOS between January 2013 and December 2015. Table 1 provides a list of the public water systems that had at least one sampling event with combined PFOA and PFOS results (i.e., the sum of PFOA value + PFOS value) above EPA's health advisory level of 70 parts per trillion (ppt) or 0.07 µg/L as of April 2016.
