The Following instructions are suggested to help eliminate point #1 in my letter of July 30, 1974. It is suggested that each step be listed separately and not placed in a paragraph.

- #1. Mix at heavy or thick consistency to remove lumps.
- #2. Bring mix to about the consistency it will be used and allow to soak for 20 to 30 minutes.
- #3. Using only a small amount of water, remix adjusting to your desired consistency.

NOTICE: When mix has been allowed to set for a short period of time, several turns with a mixer will return it to your original consistency.

It is further suggested that we start using the word "taping" instead of "Bedding". This idea originated with Dale McCubbin and I believe it better represents the phaseology being used in the field at present. Perhaps we could start by using both words throughout the printing on our bags. Not side by side but maybe from paragraph to paragraph indicating synonymity.
