Dear Dr. Mehurin:

On April 23, 1952 you granted to The B. F. Goodrich Company acceptance of Geon Resin 500X749 as a component of plastic film to be used for food packaging applications. We now have a slight modification of this formulation which we should like at this time to apply for acceptance. The modification consists in formulating with Geon 500X749 approximately 2% of calcium and zinc stearate, approximately 0.01% Ultramarine Blue, and 0.001% Violet Toner. We have identified this new formulation as Geon 81031. It does not replace 500X749 but supplements it.

You may regard this letter as an application for approval of Geon 81031 for food packaging applications in Federally inspected meat establishments.
