3 December 8th, 1992, Dr. DeLuca, you remember
4 Dr. DeLuca testified, he was Mr. Grewe's treating
5 physician. The one thing he remembered about Mr.

7 that Mr. Grewe suffered.

8 That is what he said in a matter of 10, 15
9 minutes. That is what he remembered about Mr. Grewe.

10 The other thing he remembered that he put in
11 his records back in December of 1992 was that he had a
12 strong history of asbestos exposure related to his
13 mechanic's job.

14 The other thing I want you to remember about
15 Dr. DeLuca and when the time comes to talk about
16 damages in Mr. Grewe's case and Mrs. Grewe's case, is
17 back in December of '92 right after he was diagnosed,
18 right around the end of November of '92, it was
19 discussed with him at length, with the patient and
20 Mrs. Grewe, the diagnosis and its implications, its
21 association with asbestos exposure which he has had
