It is our understanding that the SS Marne Lloyd has discharged 800 bags of TA/K Asbestos Fiber which is being held at Pacific/Oriental Terminal Pier 23, Port of San Francisco, Calif.

It is also our understanding that as of this date, January 17, 1972, a Longshoreman strike is now in effect.

Under the circumstances we are now not in a position to remove this shipment from the Pier.

For the record, pending a settlement we request that this shipment be held for our account on either a daily or monthly charge, which ever is applicable, as published in the Port of San Francisco Tariff #3-C item #355, page 22, effective September 8th, 1971.

It is hoped that settlement of this strike will be made in time to avoid following through with the above request which will alleviate our own internal problems at our headquarters for indicating storage in an outside warehouse.
