Dear Sir:

We acknowledge receipt of your letter of January 18th with regard to a skin infection which you believe is due to the spillage of Ethyl Gasoline on your hands. All gasoline, whether it contains ETHYL fluid or not, might be injurious to the skin. We have never found that the ETHYL fluid content in gasoline in any way increases this characteristic.

We are referring your letter to Dr. Robert A. Kehoe, the Medical Director of our company, whose address is University of Cincinnati, College of Medicine, Eden & Bethesda Aves., Cincinnati, Ohio, with the request that he write you direct on this subject and possibly he will be able to suggest some treatment. You should hear from him in the course of the next few days.
