As I stated in my letter of May 10, 1971, 3812-3 Reducer and Dulux® air dry enamels contain about 50% aliphatic and 50% aromatic hydrocarbons.

The 3812-3 reducer is 100% solvent and weighs 6.6 lb./gal. The Dulux® air dry enamels range in weight from 7.7 to 9.1 lb./gal. depending on the color. Solids range from 35 to 50 weight %. Thus, the amount of solvent released per gallon of paint will range from about 2.7 lb./gal. to 4.5 lb./gal. depending on the particular color. In all cases, the composition of the solvent released will be about 50% aliphatic and 50% aromatic.

I trust you will find this information satisfactory for your purposes.
