Attached is a report from Baron Consulting Company on their analysis of the water samples from our plant taken during the course of your visit on January 28 and 29, 1976. You will recall that the five samples you left with us consisted of approximately 1 gallon each, with each portion of the composite taken immediately following the portion you retained.

Because of our concern as to validity and reproducibility of results at low PCB levels, we divided the samples you left with us; after shaking to mix thoroughly, approximately one quart of each was decanted and submitted to Baron Consulting Company, and the remainder of each was submitted to Woodson-Tenent Laboratories in Memphis, Tennessee. I have not yet received a report from Woodson Tenent, but will notify you of the results when received. Naturally, we are interested in comparing with the results you obtain in your own laboratories, and would appreciate your supplying the information as soon as possible.
